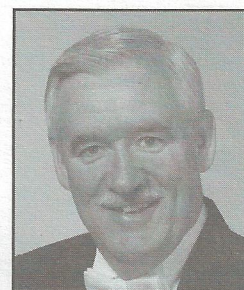

Gary R. Schwartzhoff is Professor of Music and Director of Choral Activities at the University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire, where he teaches conducting and conducts the Concert Choir, Chamber Choir, and The Singing Statesmen. Schwartzhoff received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Central College in Pella, Iowa, and a Master of Music degree in Choral Conducting from the University of Northern Iowa, Cedar Falls, Iowa. A recipient of the Helen Kemper Doctoral Fellowship Award, he received a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Conducting at the University of Missouri, Kansas City, Missouri, where he studied conducting with Dr. Eph Ehly.

Schwartzhoff has been active throughout his professional career in the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA) where he served as President of the North Central Division from 1992-94. The Wisconsin Choral Directors Association named Schwartzhoff the Outstanding Church Musician in the state of Wisconsin in 2007 and recently bestowed him with the Morris Hayes Award for lifetime achievement in the choral

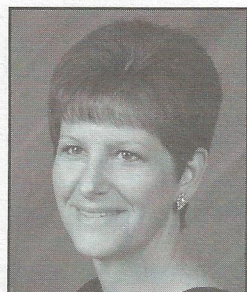

art. Schwartzhoff has presented choirs at twenty-five conventions before the state, divisional and national levels of ACDA and MENC. In 2009, Schwartzhoff was inducted into Alpha Lambda Delta and Phi Eta Sigma in recognition of scholarship, service, and commitment to student success.

Schwartzhoff is the artistic director and conductor for The Master Singers, a community chamber ensemble with membership from throughout the Greater Chippewa Valley. He serves as Director of Music at the First Congregational United Church of Christ in Eau Claire, where he conducts the Chancel Choir. Schwartzhoff has served as guest conductor and adjudicator for numerous choral festivals throughout the United States and Canada. Gary is married to Nancy Schwartzhoff and they have two daughters, Jenifer Morgan (Jerry), and Rebecca Johnson (Andy), and two grandsons, Brady and Alex. ♦

Dr. Angela Broeker is Director of Choral Activities at the University of St. Thomas where she conducts the Chamber Singers and Concert Choir and teaches undergraduate courses in choral conducting and choral methodology. She is active in the school's graduate programs in Music Education, teaching two choral conducting and two choral literature courses for students pursuing a Master's Degree in Music Education with a Choral Concentration. Since she arrived at UST in 1999, Dr. Broeker's choirs have sung at the MN Collegiate Choral Festival in 2009, the North Central Regional ACDA Convention in 2008, MMEA conventions in 2007 and 2001, and the ACDA-MN fall conference in 2004. Her choirs tour regularly and have traveled to Spain, Germany, the Czech Republic, Austria, Italy, and Greece.

Dr. Broeker received her D.M.A. degree from the University of Oklahoma, and her M.M. and B.M.E. degrees from Indiana University. Her research interests include seventeenth-century vocal music suitable for treble choirs and authentic, respectful performance of music from diverse cultures. She is currently the ACDA-MN Repertoire and Standards Chair for College & University Choirs.

Dr. Broeker served as guest editor of the April 2006 *Choral Journal* and has written articles for the April 2006 *Choral Journal*, the July 2000 *Music Educators Journal*, the MENC *Spotlight on Teaching Chorus*, and the spring 2008 *Orff Echo*, as well as many local and regional music publications. The book she coauthored with Dr. Mary Goetze and Ruth Boshkoff, *Educating Young Singers: A Choral Resource for Teacher-Conductors*, was published in October 2009. She lives in St. Paul with her dog and her composer husband Jay. ♦

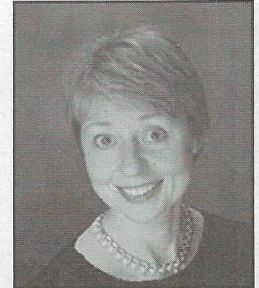

Dr. Hilary Apfelstadt is Professor of Choral Studies and Director of Choral Activities at Ohio State University. Since 2008, she has also served as Associate Director for the School of Music. She conducts the 56-voice Chorale, teaches conducting, and coordinates the graduate conducting program. For 15 years, she conducted the Women's Glee Club. Her choirs have performed at regional and national conventions of the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA) and at state and regional conferences of the National Association of Music Education (MENC). She has conducted many honor choirs and all-state choruses in Canada, the United States and Cuba, and has guest-conducted in Europe. In 2009, she conducted the Mormon Tabernacle Choir in a public broadcast of "Music and the Spoken Word."

A prolific author, she has published over seventy articles on choral music in various refereed journals, and wrote two chapters in *Wisdom, Will and Will: Women Conductors on their Art*, (GIA, 2009). She serves on the editorial boards of both the *International Journal of Research in Choral Singing* and *The Choral Scholar*, the official publication of the National Collegiate Conductors Organization (NCCO).
