Kathy Saltzman Romey graduated with a bachelor of arts in music from the University of Oregon. She continued her studies in Frankfurt, Germany, under the internationally known Bach scholar and conductor, Helmuth Rilling, receiving an artistic degree in choral conducting from the Frankfurt State Conservatory of Music in 1984. During her five years in Germany she assisted Dr. Rilling with musical activities at the Gedaechtniskirche in Stuttgart and was a member of Rilling's professional choir, the Gaechinger Kantorei. She also worked on the staff of the International Bach Academy and has been a staff member of the Oregon Bach Festival since 1984. Romey moved to the Twin Cities in the fall of 1984 as assistant conductor to Dale Warland at Macalester College, conducting both the Concert Choir and the Macalester Festival Chorale. Romey is also associate conductor of the Minnesota Chorale, the resident chorus of the St. Paul Chamber Orchestra, and director of the Chorale's chamber choir, Camerata Singers. In addition, she serves as the resident conductor of the early music ensemble, VOCALE.
