he Select Choir is an honored part of the vocal music program at Armstrong High School and is recognized throughout the region as a consistently outstanding choir.

The 88-voice choir includes junior and senior students who have been selected by audition. More than 400 of the school's 2,100 students are in the school's vocal music program. Fifty singers were selected for the 1996 Spring Tour.

Many of Armstrong's most capable students are participants in Select Choir including the student council members, captains and members of mens' and womens' athletic teams, members of the declamation team and performers in the school's award-winning drama productions.

The Armstrong Select Choir has received superior ratings at region choral contests each of the 26 years since the school's opening in 1970. Both the Select Choir and the Armstrong Chamber Singers won first place in Midwest Choral Showcase in 1995. In December 1996 the Armstrong Chamber Singers were invited to sing in the White House and the National Cathedral.

ennis Jewett is director of the Armstrong High School Choral Department. For the past seven years he has served as Associate Music Director of the Bach Society of Minnesota. He also served as a member of the Sebastian Singers and as bass section leader and frequent soloist.

He is a nationally known choral conductor and clinician. Mr. Jewett has directed festivals and all-state choirs in Alaska, North Carolina, Alabama, Nebraska, Georgia and Ohio.

He also serves as Director of Music at Good Samuritan United Methodist Church in Edina, MN.
