MSHSL Eligibility Statement

Participation with regard to curricular ensembles:

In the event of a student's **first violation** of the MSHSL Eligibility Rules, it is mandatory that the student shall lose eligibility for TWO Region 6AA and/or Classic Lake Conference Events. These performances include, but are not limited to those stated in the ensemble's annual performance calendar.

Student leadership, in any ensemble, would be revoked for a period of one calendar year.

In the event of a student's **second violation** of the MSHSL Eligibility Rules, it is mandatory that the student shall lose eligibility for all Region 6AA and Classic Lake Conference Events. These performances include, but are not limited to those stated in the ensemble's annual performance calendar.

Participation with regard to extra-curricular ensembles:

In the event of a student's **first violation** of the MSHSL Eligibility rules, it is mandatory that the student be excluded from 2 weeks participation or 2 consecutive performances, whichever is greater. These performances include, but are not limited to those stated in the ensemble's annual performance calendar. Students may be removed entirely from the ensemble at the discretion of the director.

Student leadership, in any ensemble, would be revoked for a period of one calendar year.

In the event of a student's **second violation** of the MSHSL Eligibility Rules, it is mandatory that the student be excluded from 6 weeks participation or 6 consecutive performances, whichever is greater. These performances include, but are not limited to those stated in the ensemble's annual performance calendar. Students may be removed entirely from the ensemble at the discretion of the director.

In the event of a student's **third violation** of the MSHSL Eligibility rules the student shall be removed from *each* extra-curricular performance ensemble in which they participate.

Other factors:

In the event of any student violation of the MSHSL Eligibility Rules, including academic issues, any fees associated with performances and tours are not refundable by the Armstrong Music Department, contracted tour company, or Armstrong High School.
