

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS WITH RESPECT TO AN EDUCATIONAL TRIP

The staff of Robbinsdale Area Schools, ISD 281, believes that all members of student groups have the right to a safe, respectful and productive learning environment. Maintenance of this learning environment, both in our schools and while on an educational trip, requires expectations, behavior guidelines and consequences.

A code of conduct is set forth in accordance with Robbinsdale Area Schools Discipline Policies and is in effect for all school-sponsored activities. Any deviation from the code of conduct, either on school property or while on an educational trip, will be taken very seriously. Examples of misconduct that will not be tolerated include, but are not limited to:

- Actions which present danger to the health, safety or welfare of any person, including the offender.
- Acts of sexual, religious or racial harassment or violence.
- Physical or verbal assault.
- Evidence of intoxication, possession, distribution, exchange or use of tobacco, narcotics, unauthorized drugs or alcohol as well as any other chemical substances.
- Possession or use of a weapon or weapon look-alike.
- Willful destruction of or damage to property.
- Commission of a crime, including theft.
- Insubordination.

Should such an incident of misconduct occur, disciplinary steps will be taken by school officials in accordance with district policies. Commission of certain acts might be cause for suspension or expulsion from school.

An incident taking place during the school year in which an education trip is planned will result in a revocation of the opportunity to participate in the trip for involved students. If misconduct occurs while on an educational trip, school officials and a parent/guardian will be notified immediately. Commission of certain acts might be cause for suspension or expulsion from school. School officials will be involved immediately, and disciplinary steps will be taken in accordance with district policies. In addition, students in violation of the code of conduct while on an educational trip may be sent home immediately at their own expense.
