

ARMSTRONG CHOIR TOUR
TRAVEL AGREEMENT

We do not anticipate that any of the following issues will arise with this group of students. However, as a precautionary measure the following rules have been established.

1. Students must conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the entire choir.
2. There will be no consumption of alcoholic beverages, no use of mood altering/illegal drugs, no use of tobacco and no smoking of any substance in accordance with MSHSL policies.
3. Students will not travel alone during the course of the tour. Groups of 3 or more are mandatory.
4. Students traveling with the Armstrong Choir will not reveal travel information to strangers. (i.e. Hotel information or itinerary)
5. Students will not ride in any vehicle other than the chartered bus without the permission of the director.
6. Hotel rooms are reserved for their assigned occupants ONLY. There will be a location within the hotel where students will be encouraged to congregate and socialize.
7. An evening "room check" time will be announced. After a chaperone has visually checked the student's room, **NO STUDENT MAY LEAVE THE ROOM FOR ANY REASON.** Chaperone phone numbers and room numbers will be provided to all students in the event of any emergency.
8. Only music devices with headsets are allowed.
9. Students are not allowed to bring ball caps or fashion hats on tour, or to wear them during travel.
10. Any additional costs charged to a room will be the responsibility of the occupants and will be paid to the hotel prior to check out.

The severity of the infringement will determine one of the following actions:

- ...student will be confined to the immediate supervision of a chaperone.
- ...student will not be allowed to perform/participate with the choir.
- ...student will be sent home at the parent's expense.

The above rules apply to all students, including those who are 18 years of age. These standards have been established for the protection and safety of each student and to ensure that the choir travels responsibly and respectfully.
